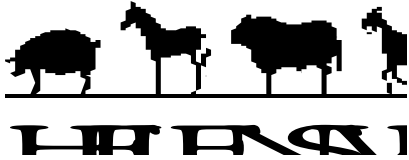

A Rich History

The first Helensville A&P Show took place in January 1900. Arranged by a keen group of locals, the Show began at the same site it occupies now, what used to be the Stewart's paddock at the North end of town. In 1909, under the direction of a newly formed committee, the Show moved to opposite the Kaipara Dairy Factory on Mill Road. It remained here (except for a few Shows at the Aitkenhead's Parakai farm) until 1955, when the property was sold and the Show returned to the original site, by then owned by the Helensville District Racing Club.

The A&P Show was always a highlight of the year for many locals and the whole district would get involved. Dairy, equestrian and indoor sections were strong from the outset and many locals recall the busy preparation in the week before the event. People travelled by train from Auckland to make the day and many others arrived by horse.

Sideshows were a popular feature, though coconut shies and merry-go-rounds preceded the huge attractions we have today. One ever popular contest involved lining beer bottles up on a fence which riders had to race past on their horses and try to knock off with a stock whip.

Show day used to end with a big ball in the evening, the favourite part for many ladies and young people. Everybody put on their Sunday best, often after having raced home for milking, and returned to the show grounds to chat, drink and dance the night away.

The Show has been associated with many other organisations over the years, including the local Lions Club, Plunket, the Historical Society and the Scouts. In fact many locals are closely involved with several of these groups at once.

Weather features prominently in our history, holding it in early December proved too risky and was one of the main reasons that the show date was changed in 1972 to be the last Saturday in February. Helensville A&P Show has continued to thrive while many other A&P shows have succumbed to changing times. Helensville A&P Show is now the largest one day show in the Northern Region and to this day is Helensville's largest event, a great day out for everybody.



General Conditions of the Helensville Agricultural & Pastoral Association

To be read in conjunction with Section Conditions and with the Rules and By-Laws of the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand.

Privacy Act

The Association holds records of names and addresses of all Members and Competitors and may publish these for the purposes of Show media reports or promotional purposes at the Association's discretion. The Association may take photographs and video images of Members, Competitors, exhibits (including livestock) and the employees, agents and assistants of any Competitor and use this information for reporting or promotional purposes in any media, at the Association's discretion.

Rights of the Helensville A&P Committee

The Helensville A&P Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without adducing any reason for so doing and reserves the right to make any alteration to the Show timetable, or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable. Any unruly or dangerous animal or exhibit may be required to leave the Showground.

Protests

All protests must be in writing, and may be lodged with the Secretary one hour from the completion of the class judged, together with a deposit of \$50.00 which shall be returned should the protest be sustained. Should the protest be lodged before the Judges proceed to their duties, the onus of proof will rest with the Competitor; thereafter, the onus of proof will be with the party protesting. No protest will be received later than one hour after the prize tickets/ribbons are affixed.


The Helensville A&P Committee, or not less than five members thereof, will determine the results of all protests as soon as practicable. There shall be no appeal.

Health & Safety

- The Association will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to or suffered by an exhibit, or which may be caused directly or indirectly by any other exhibit, notwithstanding any alleged negligence on the part of any officer or servant of the Association, and it shall be a condition of entry that each Competitor shall hold the Association indemnified against any claim in respect of any such accident, loss or damage caused by any exhibit of such Competitors. By signing the entry form declaration, Competitors accept the Association's conditions of entry and indemnify the Association under the provisions of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992.
- Each Competitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accidents, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds.

- Competitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992.
- The Association reserves the right to order immediate removal from the Showgrounds, of any animal it considers unruly or unmanageable.
- It is the Association's policy to see that all due care is taken to protect property and to protect and to keep in efficient order its own property, and to make provision for the protection of the property of others, but the Association shall not be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect howsoever arising.
- Persons occupying grandstands, buildings, other structures or other seating accommodation on the Showgrounds do so at their own risk, and no claim shall be made against the Association in respect of any loss, or injury by reason of any defect of accident, or by reason of any act or omission whether negligent or otherwise, on the part of the Association or of any employee or agent of the Association or on the part of any other person.
- Parking is entirely at the owners' own risk. Any vehicles parked will be on this condition and the Association accepts no responsibility for any loss, theft, injury or damage attributed to any negligence on the part of the Association, its employees or stewards.

- Exhibits, entry forms and correct entry money can be delivered to Helensville Show Grounds, Railway Street, from Wednesday 8 February 2012 between the hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm OR Allsorts, 44 Commercial Road, Helensville.

Before the Show

- An entry form must be completed and sent with entry fees by the closing date.
- Non perishable entries can be delivered to the Show Office at the Helensville Showgrounds from Monday, 20 February 2012 between 9:00am and 3:00pm.

Friday, 24 February 2012

- **All indoor hall entries to be delivered to the Helensville Showgrounds between 8:00am and 10:30am.**
- If you have already sent through an entry form your entries will be listed with the Steward of each section. Any other entries need to be registered as a late entry at the Office.
- Late entries will be accepted between 8am and 10:30am.
- All competitors must report to the Steward of each section to register your entries in that section.
- All entries must be registered while the competitor is still there.
- All indoor exhibits must be registered and in the Indoor exhibit hall not later than 10:30am.
- All persons must vacate the exhibit hall by 11:00am.
- All indoor exhibits will be judged at 11:30am.

Saturday, 25 February 2012 - Show Day

- The Indoor Exhibits will open for public viewing at 9:00am.
- Prize money in all classes will be awarded in full, unless otherwise stated. All prize money will be paid out on Show Day by the Secretary from 10:00am at the Show Office, otherwise in the Indoor Exhibit Hall from 4:30pm.
- All persons must vacate the exhibit hall by 3:15pm on Show Day.
- All exhibits and prizes must be collected after 4:30pm on Show Day. You must report to the Steward of the section before removing any entries.
- If you have any questions about the judging please ask the Steward of the Section involved.
